DEPARTURE

- ✓ Self-drive to Hervey Bay, or fly via major capital cities to Hervey Bay airport.
- ✓ Hervey Bay is commonly considered the gateway to Fraser Island so it makes perfect sense to start your Fraser adventure from here.
- ✓ Your two-day tour begins with a pick-up from your local Hervey Bay accommodation (between 7:00am and 8.00am), or make your own way to our Ticket Hut in River Heads for check-in by 8.30am.

WHAT TO BRING

GETTING HERE:

Self-Driving: Turn into River Heads Road . On Google Maps, this will appear as 54 Ariadne St – but you'll also see signage for Fraser Island Barges and travel straight for 8km.

Ticket Hut is located on River Heads Road (which is signed and may come up in electronic GPS navigation systems as Ariadne Road) and follow the road all the way to end to arrive at ferry loading area. The Ticket Hut will be located on your right-hand side.

PLEASE NOTE - Touring order and itinerary may vary due to tides, seasons and weather conditions.

TOUR ITINERARY

WHAT YOU'LL SEE

- **Central Station** - check-out the interp displays and discover a former logging station that was once the hub of a bustling timber industry.
- **Wangoolba Creek** - stroll along the boardwalk to discover the ancient King Ferns before hiking through
- **Pile Valley** - discover subtropical rainforests to see the island's famous Satinay Trees and King ferns.
- **Lake McKenzie** - enjoy a revitalising swim in the fresh, crystal blue water and relax on the sandy white beaches of this picture-perfect perched dune lake.
- **75 Mile Beach** - tour the golden beach highway - the 'spine of Fraser Island', running from Hook Point to Great Sandy Cape. During this journey, take an extra opportunity to join the Air Fraser team for a scenic flight over the island.
- **Eli Creek** - relax on the sandy banks, wade through the invigorating shallow waters or drift down stream - the fastest flowing creek on the island is sure to revitalise your mind, body and soul.
- **Maheno Shipwreck** - learn the intriguing history of this once proud passenger liner that was washed ashore in 1935 during an out-of-season cyclone. While you're at it, take the chance to stretch your legs and take a holiday snap with this rusting wreck.
- **The Pinnacles Coloured Sands** - one of Fraser's more magical locations, you will hear the Dreamtime story of how these rainbow coloured cliffs came to be.
- **Indian Head** - Visit the most easterly point of Fraser Island and spot marine life such as turtles and rays that inhabit the waters surrounding this rocky headland.
- **Champagne Pools** - stimulate your senses and take a dip in a natural ocean jacuzzi, a natural rock pool filled by crashing waves.
- **Lake Wabby** - swim in this emerald-green window and barrage lake, after your trek across the shifting sands of the Hammerstone Sandblow which are expected to completely swallow Lake Wabby, making this itinerary stop a rare gem.

LOCAL GUIDES

Your guide is a Fraser Island expert with local knowledge and a passion for the island. You'll explore some of the most beautiful spots and listen to fascinating facts about the island's history, fauna and flora in air-conditioned comfort. They'll drive you across the sand tracks and navigate the tides and unique terrain.

WILDLIFE

Diverse wildlife are present on Fraser Island with dingoes, birds of prey and whales (July to October) seen on Fraser Explore Tours. Spot wildlife from our 4WD coaches with custom-built panoramic windows. Keep an eye out for Fraser's most famous resident – our pure-bred dingoes!

Eurong Beach Resort offers twin, triple and single hotel rooms along the spectacular 75 Mile Beach. Each resort room has been recently renovated and includes a private ensuite and balcony.
