EX-HERVEY BAY

DEPARTURE

- ✓ Self-drive to Hervey Bay, or fly via major capital cities to Hervey Bay airport.
- ✓ Hervey Bay is commonly considered the gateway to Fraser Island so it makes perfect sense to start your Fraser adventure from here.
- ✓ Your two day tour begins with a pick-up from your Hervey Bay accommodation (between 7.00am and 8.00am), or make your own way to our Ticket Hut in River Heads for check-in by 8.00am.
- ✓ Spot playful dolphins, turtles and dugongs during your 30 minute cruise across the Great Sandy Marine Park.

WHAT TO BRING

- ✓ Pack a day bag with swimmers, towel, hat, sunscreen, insect repellent, comfortable walking shoes or sandals, sunglasses, essential medication and don't forget your camera. We do provide water, but a reusable water bottle is always handy and great for the environment.

- ✓ 2 full-day guided 4WD tour with expert commentary.
- ✓ 1 night motel style accommodation at Eurong Beach Resort.
- ✓ Courtesy pick-up and drop-off.

GETTING HERE:

Self-Driving: Turn into River Heads Road . On Google Maps, this will appear as 54 Ariadne St - but you'll also see signage for Fraser Island Barges and travel straight for 8km.

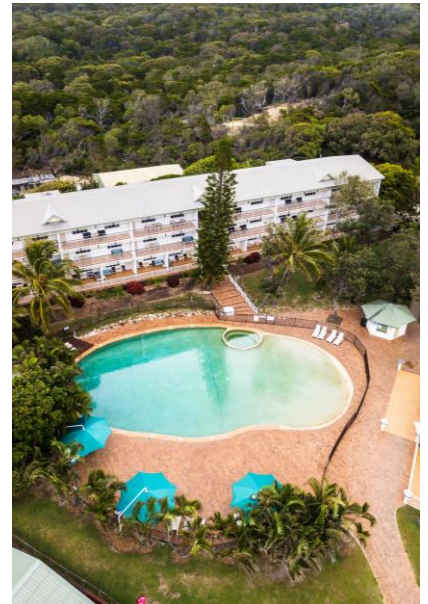
Ticket Hut is located on River Heads Road (which is signed and may come up in electronic GPS navigation systems as Ariadne Road) and follow the road all the way to end to arrive at ferry loading area. The Ticket Hut will be located on your right-hand side.

PLEASE NOTE - Touring order and itinerary may vary due to tides, seasons and weather conditions.

Tour Itinerary

WHAT YOU'LL SEE

- **Central Station** - admire the towering trees growing in nothing but sand and learn why Fraser Island was so valuable to the timber industry. Stroll along the Wanggoolba Creek boardwalk and discover the 'invisible creek' silently flowing through the rainforest.
- **Pile Valley** - walk through the subtropical rainforest to see the famous marine borer resistant Satinay Trees used line the banks of the Suez Canal and to rebuild the London Docks after World War II.
- **Lake McKenzie** - relax on its white sandy beaches and swim in its crystal blue water.
- **75 Mile Beach** - hit Fraser Island's golden beach highway as you make your way north. Keen for a bird's eye view or some amazing aerial photos? Join Air Fraser for a scenic joy-flight over the island (optional extra).
- **Eli Creek** - wade through the shallow waters or float down stream towards the Coral Sea!
- **Maheno Shipwreck** - view the famous rusting wreck that was once a luxury cruise liner, washed ashore in 1935 it is now a photographers paradise!
- **The Pinnacles Coloured Sands** - be amazed by these spectacularly technicoloured sand cliffs and the Dreamtime tale of how they were formed.
- **Indian Head** - climb to the top of this rocky headland for spectacular beach and ocean views. Look out for sharks, rays and turtles, even migrating humpback whales (July - November) and take in the rolling sand dunes.
- **Champagne Pools** - experience this amazing natural jacuzzi formed by the crashing waves meeting the volcanic rock pools lining the shore.
- **Lake Wabby** - trek across Hammerstone Sandblow with your expert guide and be rewarded with a dip in this emerald green lake. Several species of fish live in the lake including catfish, rainbow fish and the rare honey blue-eye.



Tour Details

LOCAL GUIDES

Your guide is a Fraser Island expert with local knowledge and a passion for the island. You'll explore some of the most beautiful spots and listen to fascinating facts about the island's history, fauna and flora in air-conditioned comfort. They'll drive you across the sand tracks and navigate the tides and unique terrain.

WILDLIFE

Diverse wildlife are present on Fraser Island with dingoes, birds of prey and whales (July to October) seen on Fraser Explore Tours. Spot wildlife from our 4WD coaches with custom-built panoramic windows. Keep an eye out for Fraser's most famous resident – our pure-bred dingoes!

ACCOMMODATION

Eurong Beach Resort offers quad, triple, twin and single hotel rooms or two-bedroom apartments. Each room has a private ensuite and deck. The resort offers many facilities for guest use however, the best place to unwind is at McKenzie's on 75 Bar, otherwise you can go for a stroll and watch a magical sunset over the Pacific Ocean.

DROP OFF

At the end of the second day, board the 5.00pm ferry back to River Heads where our shuttle service will take you back to your accommodation (drop-off between 6.00pm and 7.00pm).
